### George R. Schlossberg

Mr. Schlossberg is a Kutak Rock partner resident in the firm's Washington DC office and Chair of the firm's Federal Practice and National Security Law Group. He represents state and local governments, Federal Departments and Agencies, and private entities in connection with the reuse of military installations, government and commercial real property transactions, government contracts and the financing of government and commercial facilities. Mr. Schlossberg serves also as General Counsel to the Association of Defense Communities (ADC), the national organization that represents state and local communities with active, closed and closing military installations.

Prior to joining Kutak Rock, Mr. Schlossberg served for 10 years in various positions in the Pentagon, including Senior Counsel in the Office of the Secretary of Defense. In that position, he advised the Secretary of Defense and the Secretary's immediate staff on matters related to real property, base closures, defense installations, international agreements, the leasing, construction and private financing of defense facilities, and government contracts. During his tenure with the Defense Department, Mr. Schlossberg served also as Counsel to the Office of Economic Adjustment, Counsel to the President's Economic Adjustment Committee, Counsel to the President's Commission on Alternative Utilization of Military Facilities, Counsel to the Department of Defense's Bureau of Prisons Assistance Council and Assistant Counsel to the Naval Facilities Engineering Command. While with the Office of the Secretary of Defense, he was instrumental in the drafting and policy implementation of the original 1988 Base Closure Act (*Defense Authorization Amendments and the Base Closure and Realignment Act*), and testified frequently before Congressional committees on matters relating to Defense real property, construction and the financing of defense facilities.

In 2005, Mr. Schlossberg was appointed to the Department of Veterans Affairs Construction Advisory Board by Veterans Affairs Secretary R. James Nicholson; the Board is responsible for providing advice and policy guidance to the Secretary and Deputy Secretary on the nature and scope of the Department's construction activities

Mr. Schlossberg earned his bachelor's degree from the State University of New York at Stony Brook in 1973 and his law degree from The New England School of Law in 1976. His bar affiliations include those of the District of Columbia, the State of New York and the United States Supreme Court.
