1. Where are you with overall statewide integration (in terms of your vision or goals)?

Statewide Goal: To improve criminal justice records

- Law enforcement, corrections, prosecutors and courts to use Process Control Number (PCN) assigned to every arrest/fingerprinting event.
- Courts to provide juvenile and adult probation data access through the Arizona Criminal Justice Information System (ACJIS) network with a 2-minute response and 24 hour currency.
- By 2005, with a 2 minute response and 24 hour currency:
 - All agencies to have access to fingerprint-supported criminal history via ACJIS with 2 minute response and 24 hour currency.
 - ACJIS to have current, complete and accurate criminal prosecution information from all justice partners.
- By 2010
 - Local city and county agencies, including law enforcement, prosecutors and courts, integrated for information sharing.

2. What components of your state's integrated justice system are operational?

- Arizona Fingerprint Identification System (AFIS) and LiveScan is deployed statewide for identification and assigning PCN.
- Messaging infrastructure built and in use. Courts and Department of Public Safety using IBM's MQSeries.
- Courts' project reporting dispositions electronically.
- Courts' pilot project providing detail of all court-issued protective orders to law enforcement.
- Pilot local agency integration in one AZ county.

3. Where are you headed next in terms of implementation?

- Complete work on access to juvenile and adult information via messaging.
- Implement electronic disposition reporting by courts statewide via messaging.
- Support local prosecutor electronic disposition reporting to DPS via messaging within the local agency integration efforts.
- Work in pilot AZ county to create local data sharing with MQ infrastructure in place there.
