NOTES

Democrat (D), *Republican (R)*

- a) American Samoa Lt. Governor Togiola T.A. Tulafono became governor on April 7, 2003, following the death of Governor Tauese Sunia on March 26, 2003.
- b) Arkansas Lt. Governor Mike Huckabee became governor in July 1996 after Governor Jim Guy Tucker resigned. Governor Huckabee was elected to full four-year terms in November 1998 and November 2002.
- c) Arnold Schwarzenegger was elected governor of California in October 2003 following the recall of Governor Gray Davis. Governor Schwarzenegger was inaugurated on November 17, 2003.
- d) Connecticut Lt. Governor M. Jodi Rell became Governor on July 1, 2004 following the resignation of Governor John G. Rowland.
- e) Absolute two-term limitation, but terms need not be consecutive.
- f) Indiana Lt. Governor Joseph E. Kernan became governor on September 13, 2003, following the death of Governor Frank O'Bannon.
- g) Absolute limit of eight years of service out of every 16 years.
- h) After two consecutive terms as governor, the candidate must wait four years before becoming eligible to run again.
- i) Two-year term.
- j) New Jersey Senate President Governor Richard Codey became acting governor on November 15, 2004 following the resignation of Governor James E. McGreevey.
- k) New Jersey Acting Governor Richard Codey previously served as acting governor from 12:01 a.m. January 12, 2002 to 12:00 noon January 15, 2002, when he split the responsibility of acting governor with state Senate Co-president John Bennett. This occurred between the expiration of New Jersey Senate President Donald T. DiFrancesco's term, who had been serving as acting governor, and the swearing in of then Governor-elect James E. McGreevey.
- l) Texas Lt. Governor Rick Perry became governor in December 2000 when Governor George W. Bush was elected President. Governor Perry was elected to a full four-year term in November 2002.
- m) Utah Lt. Governor Olene Walker became governor on November 5, 2003 after Governor Michael O. Leavitt became Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
- n) Two-year term.
- o) Governor cannot serve immediate successive terms.
