Getting to the Goal: Math!

Starting with Goal 2025	
Estimated US population in 2025 (age 25-64)	175.6 million
X 60%	x 0.60
60% of estimated population	105.4 million
How many people already have credentials?	
Current credential holders, age 18-54	64.8 million
New credential holders by 2025	+24.2 million
Credential holders in 2025	89 million (50.7%)



More Math!

How many additional credential holders to reach Goal 2025?60% goal105.4 million50.7% projected– 89.0 million= 16.4 million


Who can help us get there?	
Ages 25-64 in 2025	175.7 million
Ages 25-64 with credentials in 2025	- 89.0 million
Opportunity population	= 86.7 million




Very Compelling Math!

Who makes up the opportunity population (86.7m)?


Students, age 16-24 Adults, some college Adults, no college




