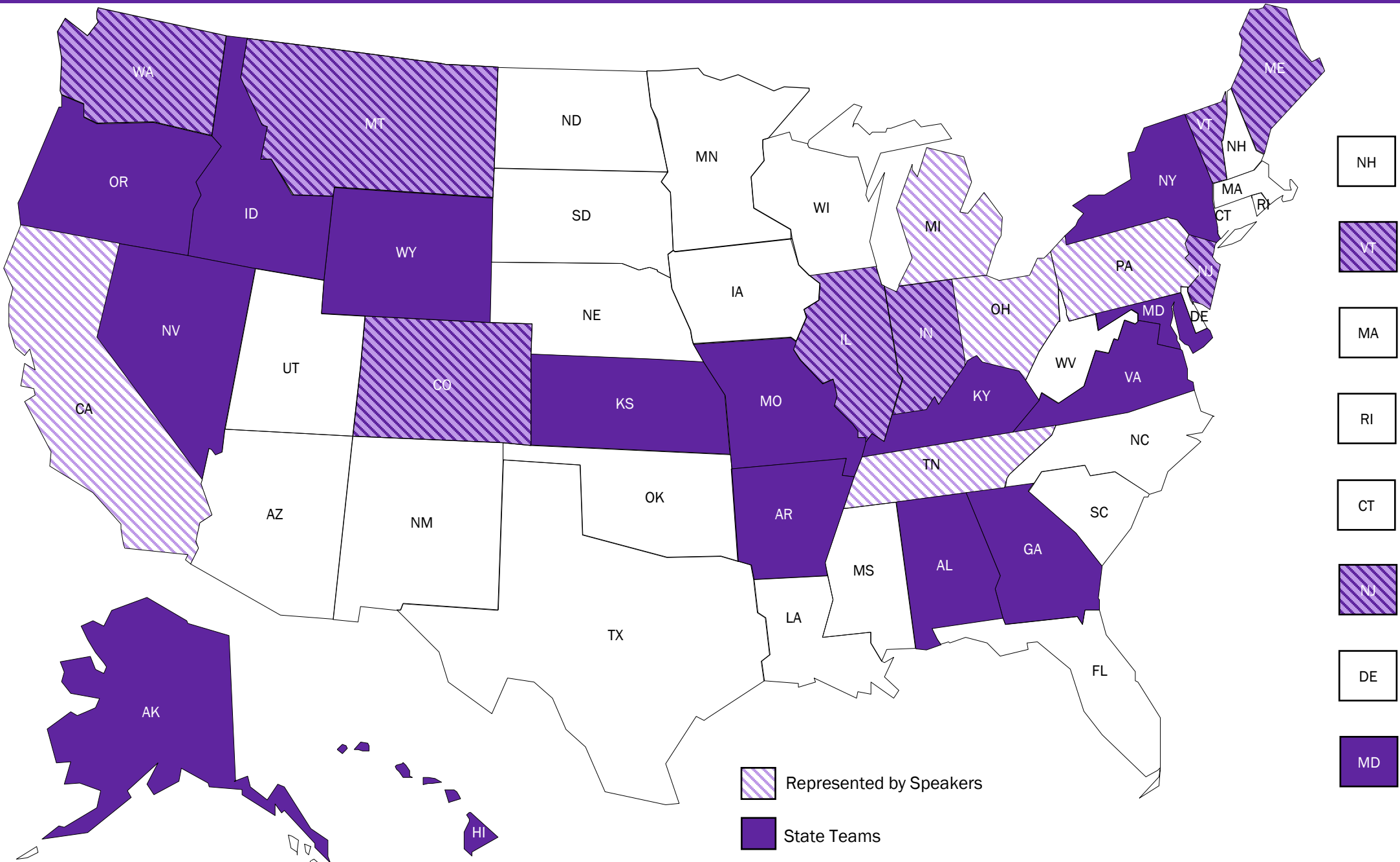

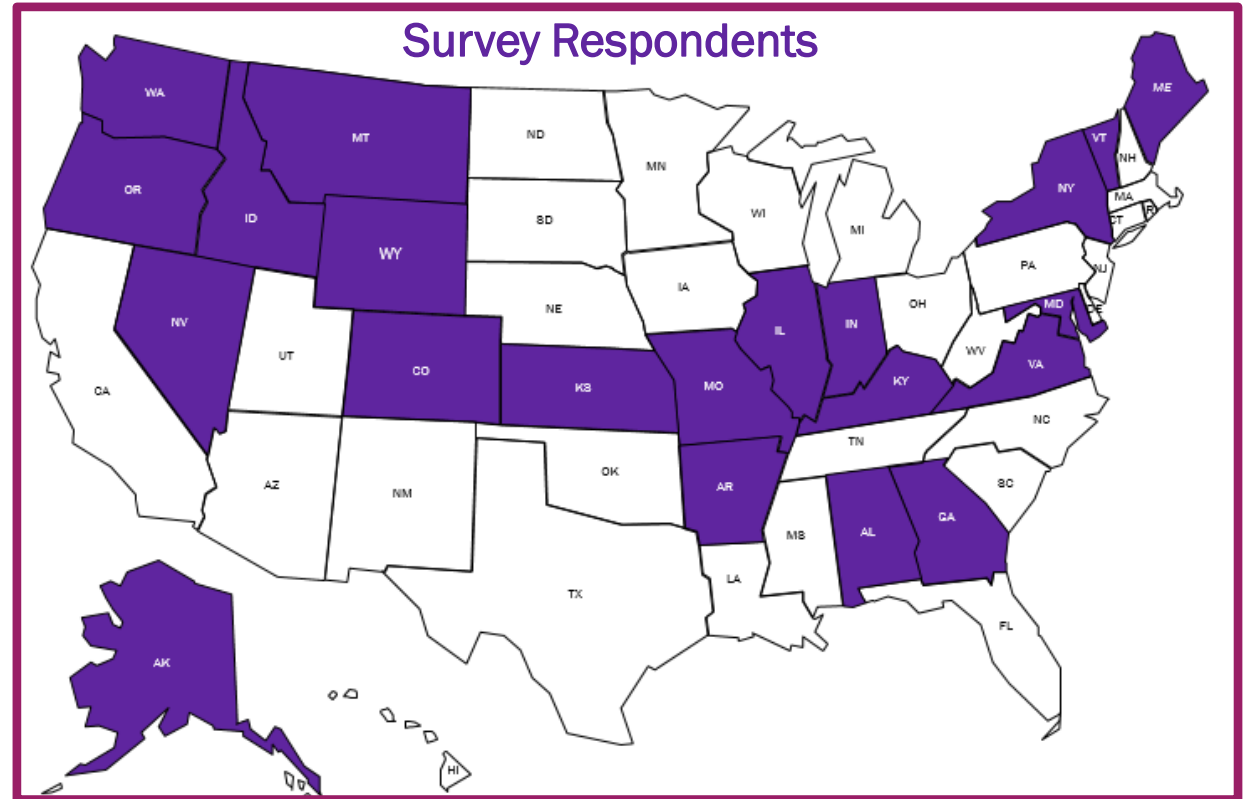
States Represented at the Future Workforce Now State Policy Forum For Action

The survey was designed to:

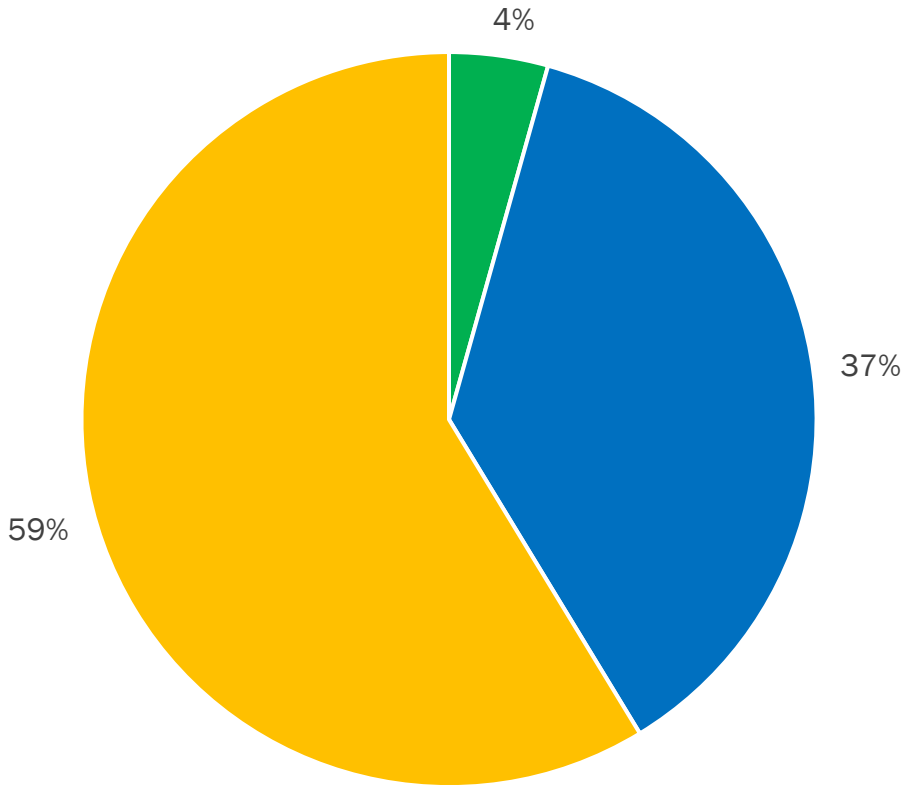
- Gauge states' readiness to address each of the challenges in the Future Workforce Now draft policy framework

Challenge #1

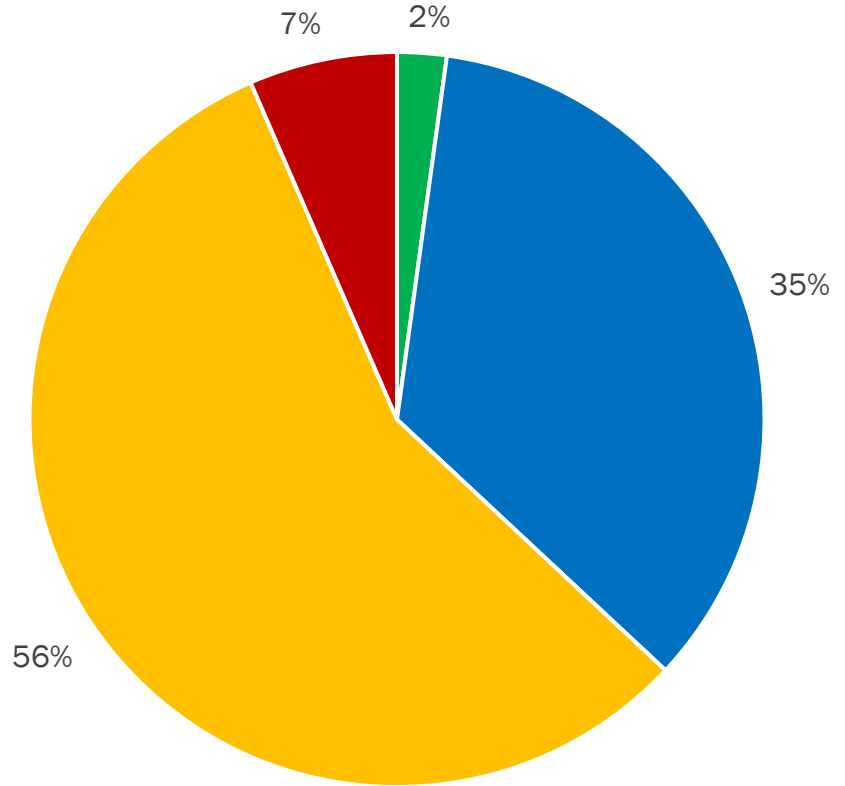
How well prepared is your state to build inclusive systems & infrastructure that support and enable lifelong learning?

Challenge #2

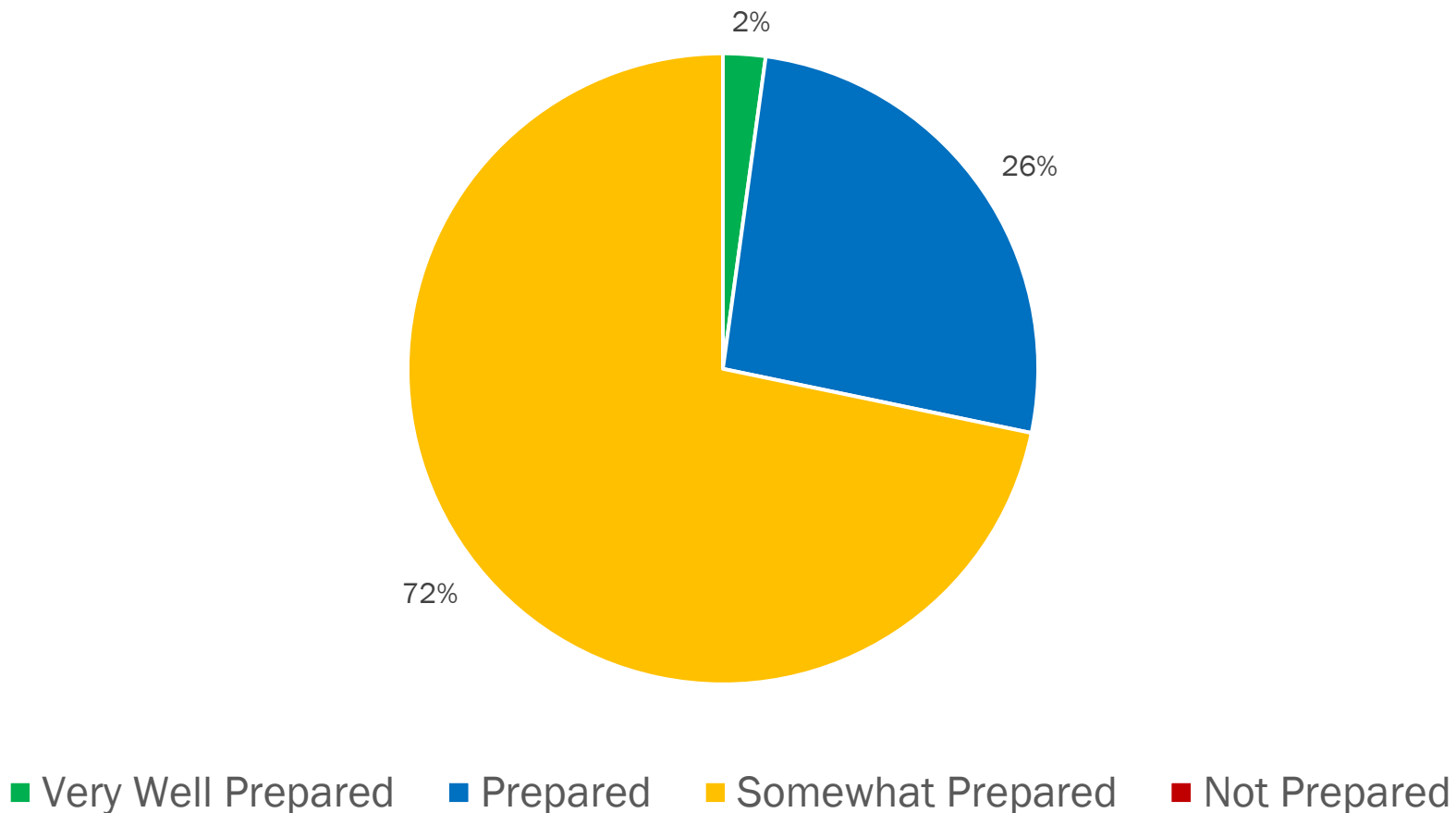
How well prepared is your state to develop an agile, tech-ready workforce?



Very Well Prepared Prepared Somewhat Prepared Not Prepared

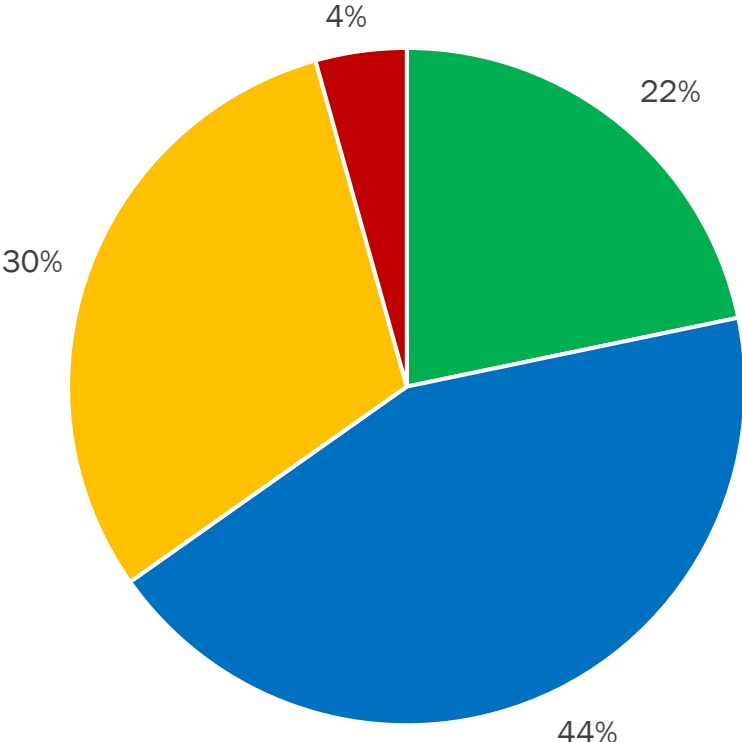
Challenge #3
