





ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS


In the 2014-15 school year, **the number of English Language learners was 4.6 million, or**



of total public school enrollment.


STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

In the 2014-15 school year, the **number of children and youth served under IDEA was 6.6 million**, or




