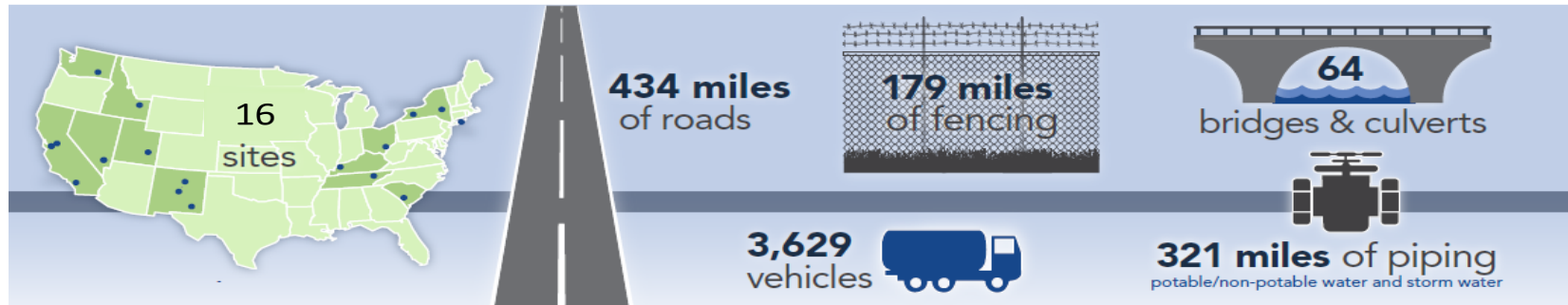

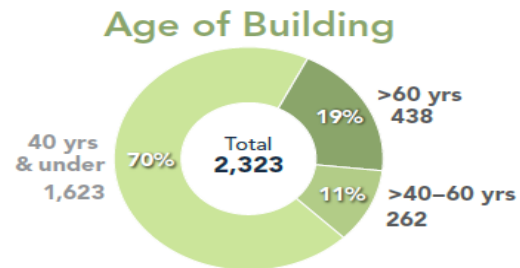

EM Infrastructure Snapshot*

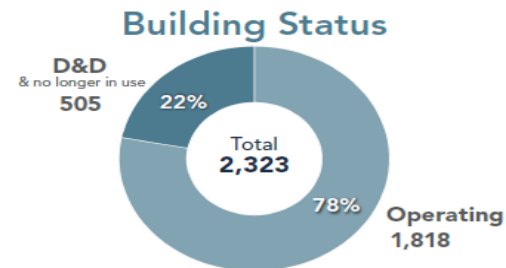

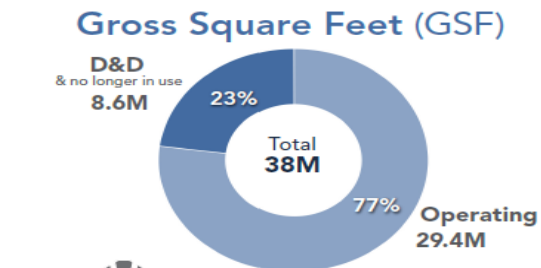

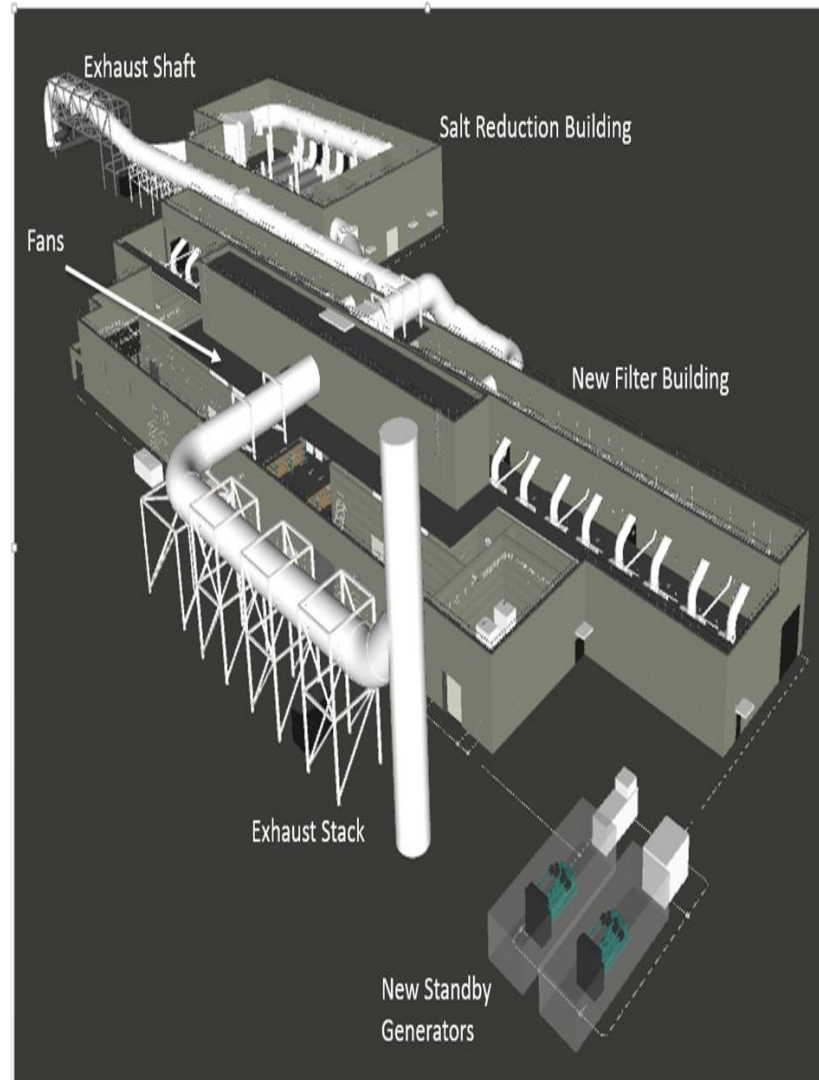

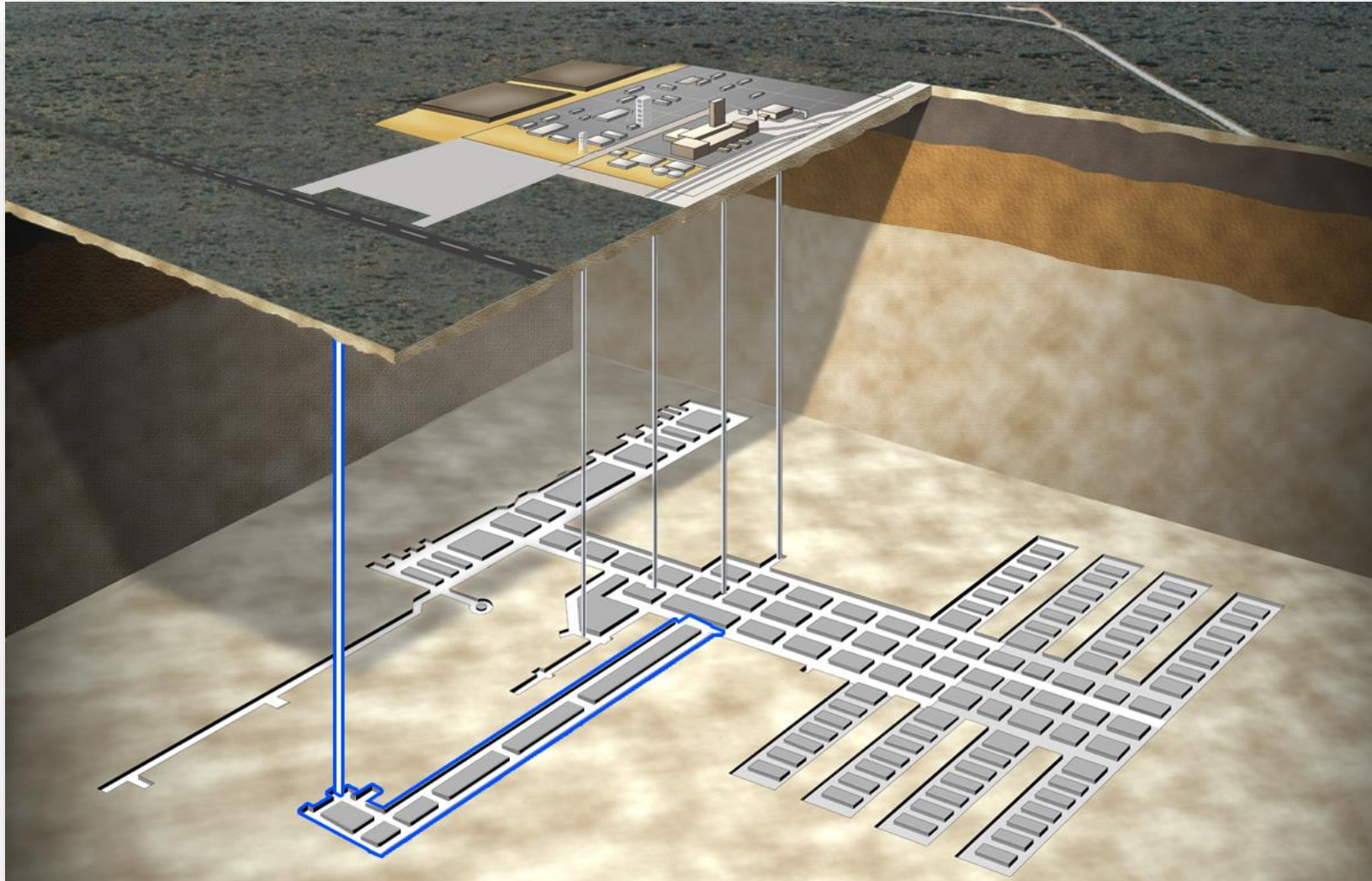
WIPP Aging Infrastructure

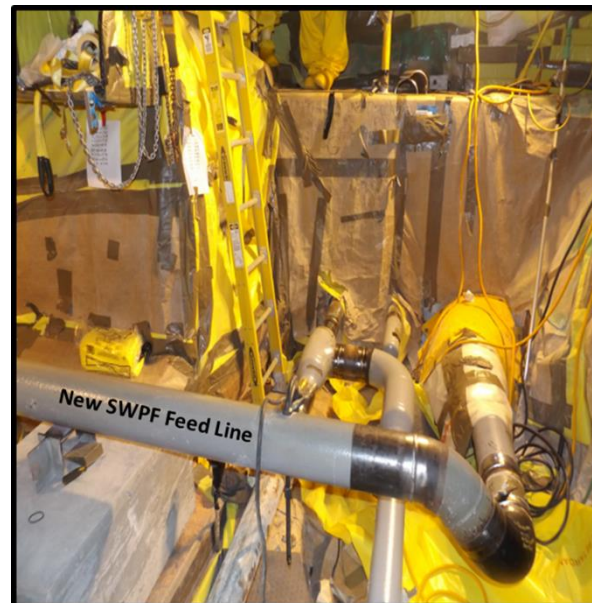
