- ^ The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) began [requiring](#) testing of residents and staff in LTC facilities on August 26, 2020. CMS [updated](#) the methodology that determines required frequency of testing on September 23, 2020. Prior to federal requirements, many states required facilities to test residents and staff, including: [AK](#), [CA](#), [CT](#), [FL](#), [IL](#), [MD](#), [MA](#), [MI](#), [MN](#), [MT](#), [NJ](#), [NY](#), [NC](#), [OH](#), [PA](#), [TN](#), [VA](#), [VT](#), [WA](#), [WV](#).
- ± State-led teams deployed to assist LTC facilities in preventing and mitigating outbreaks, which may include local and state health officials, clinicians, providers from local hospital systems, and members of the National Guard.
- ~ Examples of new and expanded roles include temporary nurse aides and personal care attendants.
